Duff's bar in Williamsburg might appear to be constructed of wood, but it was actually built on metal. The hard rockers paradise, owned by Jimmy Duff (formerly of the infamous Hell's Kitchen headbangers bar Bellevue), is an approximately 400-square-foot room (with an adjoining patio space) that is covered with vintage concert posters, photos of nude pinups, a giant coffin and other metal-head accessories. Scruffy hipsters and tattooed hard-core regulars can be found downing one-dollar Pabst Blue Ribbon specials or whisky shots while mining the well-stocked jukebox that boasts everything from Iron Maiden to Metal Mike's Pain Museum.
